Dear Steven,

The project has been given enthusiastic approval. Thank you for this superb summary. It raises scores of questions, which I would like to go over with you in person. I will be very interested in any documentation you can provide me with. Following that I will also seek your advice in fashioning a series of queries, presumably in writing, to submit to the company in question.

We are pushing forward the travel plans, with the possibility that I would arrive in Quito this Friday evening, Jan 26.

Is there any chance you will be in town over the weekend, and available for lengthy discussions? Ideally I would like to meet the former Supreme Court judge as well, presumably after you and I have talked.

The way I see the (tentative) schedule, after the weekend in Quito, I would head to Lago on Monday Jan 29, and plan to spend a week, maybe two, tagging along with Pablo.
