I am not sure if Laura told you but I have been speaking with a news show here in Australia called Sunday Night. I was incensed when I saw the Chevron adverts here about supporting indigenous people etc. and so I approached an ex 60 minutes reporter Mike Monro, who was a great friend of my mothers after he did a 60 minutes piece on her when I was 12. I hadn't seen him since then! I told them all about the case and Mike and the producer did their own research and declared the US 60 minutes piece on the case rather weak. They want to do a much harder hitting piece, they are keen to ask very hard questions of Andrea Neuman in particular.

They are definitely coming to do a piece on the case and would love to interview you of course. They will be in Ecuador 7th - 10th March inclusive in Lago etc. They will rest for a day in Quito before and then they are going to go and do a little filming in Sarayacu. They will also be interviewing me as they need an Australian connection for the piece.

May I put the producer Fiona Baker in touch with you? Are you available to be in Lago between those dates?

These guys are very good at what they do and I can vouch for them completely. I am sure they will send you DVD's of other stories they have done for you to check them out and here is the link to the show -
